


VOTER ID

Learn what photo IDs you will need for coming elections

If you are a registered voter and do not have one of the IDs listed, and need one for voting purposes, you are entitled to get one **FREE OF CHARGE** at a PennDOT Driver License Center (DLC).

To find the DLC nearest you, what is needed to get a photo ID, how to vote if you have a religious objection to having your photograph taken, what identification is needed to vote by absentee ballot, or for general information, visit **VotesPA.com** or call 1-877-VotesPA (868-3772).

All photo IDs must contain an expiration date that is current, unless noted otherwise.



Acceptable IDs include:

- ✓ Photo IDs issued by the Commonwealth of PA or the U.S. Government
- ✓ PA Driver's License or Non-driver's License photo ID (IDs are valid for voting purposes 12 months past expiration date)
- ✓ PA Department of State Voter ID Card
- ✓ Photo ID from an accredited PA public or private college, university or seminary
- ✓ Photo ID issued by a PA care facility, including long-term care facilities, assisted living residences or personal care homes
- ✓ U.S. military ID - active duty and retired military (a military or veteran's ID must designate an expiration date or designate that the expiration date is indefinite). Military dependents' ID must contain an expiration date
- ✓ Valid U.S. passport
- ✓ Employee photo ID issued by Federal, PA, PA County or PA Municipal government
