- You are expected to serve the ENTIRE day from 6 am to 9 pm! Please do not schedule any events on Election Day.
- Arrange Transportation to and from the polling place ahead of time.
- Dress appropriately and comfortably (no attire with political affiliations).
- Bring snacks and beverages to last throughout the day.
Please note: Meals are not provided.
- You will receive your stipend 4 - 6 weeks after Election Day.

What is the Student Poll Worker Program?

The Venango County Student Poll Worker Program provides high school students with an exciting opportunity to serve as poll workers on Election Day!

Responsibilities include:

- Setting up/opening polling place
- Assisting voters
- Closing the polling place
- Counting ballots

Who Can Apply?

- Students 17 years or older
- U.S. Citizen and resident of Venango County
- Good academic standing G.P.A. 2.5 or greater
- Must have teacher recommendation
- Must have principal approval
- Must have parental/guardian consent

What are the Benefits of the Program?

- Receive up to \$80.00, or Community Service hours
- Hands-on introduction to the democratic process
- Looks great on college/scholarship applications and resumes

Is Training Provided?

Training is provided at the County Annex Building and is mandatory.

Remember, attending poll worker training accounts for \$10 of your Election Day pay!

Student Poll Workers Needed for Upcoming Elections!

Elections are held twice a year, in the Spring and in the Fall. Additional Poll Workers are always needed to facilitate the Democratic process.
